

<b>About Canada</b>	Feature that allows learners to study for the Canadian Citizenship test.
<b>Copy</b>	Copies the text in a presentation window into the Writing Pad.
<b>Dictionary</b>	Provides definitions and pronunciation of the underlined words in the presentation screens.
<b>Display window</b>	A window that displays a picture and text, with toolbars on either side. Also called presentation window, or presentation screen.
<b>Exercise</b>	Accesses either a text exercise or a map exercise.
<b>Fact</b>	Lists additional facts for a section.
<b>Go To</b>	Feature that allows the learner to jump to a specific page in a presentation screen.
<b>Help</b>	Provides explanations on screen for all the icons on the toolbars in the presentation screens and the Writing Pad.
<b>Index</b>	An alphabetical listing of key words that are linked to their occurrences in the program.
<b>Level buttons</b>	Allow the learner to choose Level 1, a brief text with audio, or Level 2, a longer text with no audio.
<b>Main</b>	Accesses the History and Geography menus.
<b>Map exercise</b>	An exercise where the learner matches a picture to a location on a map.
<b>Mouse Tutorial</b>	Instructions on how to use a mouse.
<b>Presentation screen</b>	See display window.
<b>Presentation window</b>	See display window.
<b>Text exercise</b>	An exercise where the learner drags the correct words or phrases to complete sentences.
<b>Tips</b>	Provide information on features of the presentation window, Writing Pad, and Index.
<b>Tutorial/Introduction</b>	Instructions on how to use the program.
<b>Writing Pad</b>	A text editor that can be used to create text or copy text from a presentation window.
